

Antifreeze, Batteries, CRTs, Bulbs, & Mercury Containing Devices

FOLLOW THESE STEPS FOR PROPER DISPOSAL:

1. Do not put these items in your household trash. They contain mercury, lead, cadmium, and other substances that are hazardous to human health and the environment.
2. Check with your municipality to see if they can accept these items. In many cases it is less expensive to dispose of them through your municipality than it is to bring them to a household hazardous waste (HHW) collection. Help keep HHW disposal costs down.
3. Cathode ray tubes are NOT accepted at HHW collections. All other items can be brought to a HHW collection if they cannot be disposed of through your municipality. For more info visit www.nashuarpc.org/hhw or call 603-417-6570.
